

"Deirdre Mullan, RSM, is a Sister of Mercy from Ireland who served as the executive director of Mercy Global Concern at the United Nations for more than 10 years. In 2011

she became the Director of The Partnership for Global Justice, a network of over 125 small congregations at the U.N. Her present ministry is working with UNICEF to look at ways in which they can partner with religious communities. During the height of unrest in Northern Ireland, Mullan spent 25 years as a teacher and administrator in schools, where she saw firsthand what hate and misinformed ideologies can do to young minds. She has a doctorate degree in the Feminization of Poverty and has long been active in promoting the education of girls."
